

Hunts Kart Racing Club Photography Policy



Purpose

At Hunts Kart Racing Club, we understand that photographs and videos can be an important way to document and share our activities with the community. However, we also recognize that photographs and videos can raise privacy and safety concerns, particularly when children and vulnerable adults are involved.

As such, we have developed a Photograph and Filming Policy to ensure that all members and visitors are aware of the guidelines and expectations for taking and sharing photographs and videos at the club. The purpose of this policy is to promote the safety, privacy, and dignity of all members and visitors, particularly those who may be at risk of harm.

We are committed to creating a safe and inclusive environment for all members and visitors, and this policy is an important part of that commitment.

Permissions

The taking of still or moving images which are to be used for personal gain (even if no charges are sought) is strictly prohibited unless express permission has been sought from the club prior to the event taking place. The club will only grant permission to photographers/ media personnel who possess the relevant public liabilities insurance and for the purposes for photographing particular teams or individuals.

The club has arrangements in place with reputable photographic and media companies for wider event coverage.

By signing on to each event you agree to have your still or moving images taken and used by the club for purposes of promotion of the club and to celebrate achievements.

When signing on for under 18s the parent/guardian is agreeing to still or moving images being taken of the minor they are signing on.

The Club Will:

- Only use photographs and filming for legitimate purposes, such as promoting the club, recording events, and celebrating achievements.
- Ensure that photographs and filming are appropriate and respectful. We will not use any photographs or filming that may be considered inappropriate or offensive.
- The club will not use any photographs or filming that may put the safety or welfare of any members at risk.
- The club will not use any photographs or filming that may put the safety or welfare of any members at risk.

The club expects members and visitors to:

- Be considerate when taking photographs for personal use, such as social media or simply for capturing memories of the event.
- Not take pictures of minors in the paddock, assembly area or grid without permission from the minors parent or guardian
- Take photographs of the track action from the outside perimeter of the track and not place themselves in a place of danger.
- Always follow the instructions or requests of Motorsport UK officials or club staff.

Raise Concerns

If you are aware of images being taken which you feel are contrary to this policy or you feel by being taken, they are placing someone at risk you **MUST** always contact the club safeguarding officer, Jamie Roe. During an event this is to be completed by speaking with race control staff who will ensure the CSO is contacted.
